SPECIALIZED SERVICE RIDE CRITERIA:

1. Availability of rides/routes may change with the school calendar (September - June)
2. Deadhead miles will be charged for one leg of trip if the length of the rider's trip is equal to or greater than the revenue trip.
3. Peak times = 6:00am - 8:30am; 2:00pm - 4:30pm. Booking rides may be more difficult during these times. Plan accordingly.
4. Passengers will be given a 30-day notice if their transportation is changing or being cancelled.
